



Midtown Children's Ministry Information

Here is a list of the children's ministry classes and a few special things that you need to know.

Nursery – Newborn through 20 months

- Please use Enter and Exit doors to help alleviate hallway traffic.
- Child must be checked in by a parent/guardian who will receive a clip. The child will only be released to the adult who has possession of the clip.
- Please label sippy cups, as well as diapers and bottles if you don't bring a diaper bag.

Toddlers – 21 through 36 Months

- Graduation can occur prior to the child being 21 months and is to be determined by parent/guardian and nursery teacher based on the following guidelines:
 1. Child can sit in a toddler chair without falling;
 2. Child can eat a graham cracker without choking; and
 3. Child can enter classroom without distress caused by separation from parent.
- Child must be checked in by a parent/guardian who will receive a clip. The child will only be released to the adult who has possession of the clip.
- Please label sippy cups, as well as diapers and bottles if you don't bring a diaper bag.

Preschool Classroom

- Children may graduate to the preschool classroom upon turning 3 years old AND being potty trained.
- Child must be checked in by a parent/guardian who will receive a clip. The child will only be released to the adult who has possession of the clip.

Graduation for children entering Kindergarten through 6th grade will occur on the first Sunday of August.

K – 1st Grade Classroom

- Child must be checked in by a parent/guardian who will receive a clip. The child will only be released to the adult who has possession of the clip.

2nd – 4th Grade Classroom

- Child must be checked in by a parent/guardian who will receive a clip.
- Children will be released during church service to classroom.
- The child will only be released to the adult who has possession of the clip.

5th – 6th Grade Classroom

- Children will be released during church service to classroom.
- A parent or guardian needs to pick the child up from the classroom at the end of service.

Sick Policy

We care a great deal about the health and well being of families and children. We ask that parents keep children out of the Children's Ministry facilities if they exhibit any of the following symptoms:

- Fever
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Questionable Rash
- Severe Coughing
- Eye Discharge
- Yellowish Skin or Eyes
- Any Communicable Disease
- Green or Yellow Runny Nose
- Sore Throat with Fever and Swollen Glands
