# Ministry Teams

## Why serve?

As the Body of Christ, we are each an integral part of the living, breathing, ever-growing church. Jesus told us to love one another and serving on a ministry team enables us to show the love of Christ by providing for the needs of others. Below are some opportunities to use your gifts or to explore new areas where God is calling you to serve. Most ministries are at both sites, but are noted as Midtown or West if site specific.

## Children's Ministry

We offer children 12 and younger the opportunity to learn and grow with Jesus in our children's ministry. Those serving in the classrooms provide age-appropriate teaching to augment what the child is learning about Jesus in their home.

### Teachers

Teachers monitor and supervise all classroom activities as well as restroom or changing diapers. Teachers serve 3 months per year and attend regular children's ministry training.

### Substitutes

Substitutes are called "last minute" to teach in any classroom. They assume the role of the teacher.

### Teaching Assistants (Toddler)

Teaching Assistants in the toddler room help the classroom teacher with all activities in the classroom as well as restroom and changing diapers.

### Floater

Floater check on all classrooms before and during service to help teachers maintain safe teacher:child

ratios and jump in to help when necessary. They also page parents and assist in an emergency.
