Mission Groups

What is a mission group?

A mission group is usually formed as a result of two or more persons who sense a calling from God to address some need/pain in the community, nation, or world and to carry out the calling in community with others who share this calling.



Stages of a mission group:



STAGE 1: THE SEEDAN IDEA IS FORMED

Possible Questions to Ask:

Does anyone else at CG share this passion? Is there anyone else in the city doing this work? Is this idea missional? (How does it help others?) What resources are needed?

STAGE 2: GERMINATION

PREPARATION BEGINS

Possible Questions to Ask:

What is our mission statement? What specific problems are we tackling/solving? How often and when does the group meet? What is the group structure?



STAGE 3: SPROUT

BRING ABOUT LIFE

Possible Group To-Dos:

Finalize a "charter" with mission statement. Publicize opportunities for involvement. Test and iterate missional activities (awareness, advocacy, action).



STAGE 4: PLANT

GROW AND SUSTAIN

Possible Group To-Dos:

Discern CG involvement/support. Create an annual work plan and budget. Formalize team membership/roster. Create website and/or communication plan.
